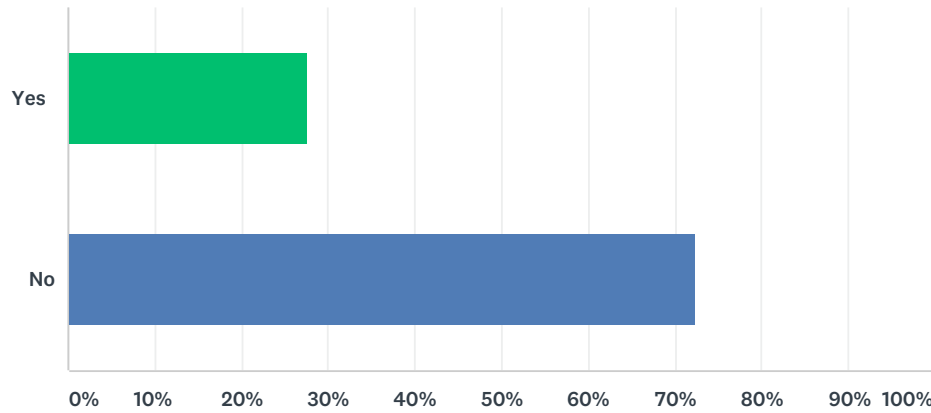

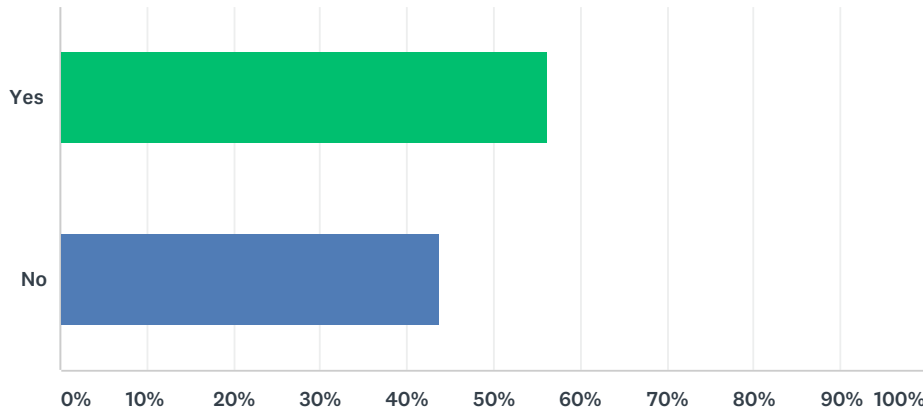

### Q3 Has the entire month of month of April been successfully set aside in your county for club activity?

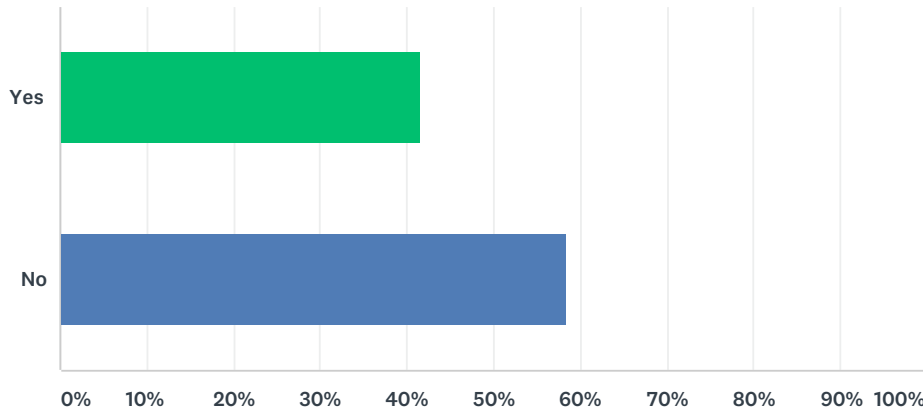

### Q4 Have you received a master fixture plan with specified dates for all games for the remainder of 2018?

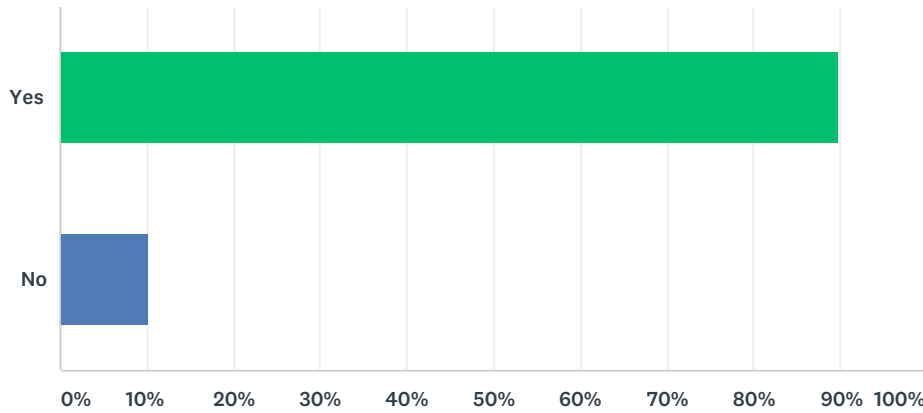

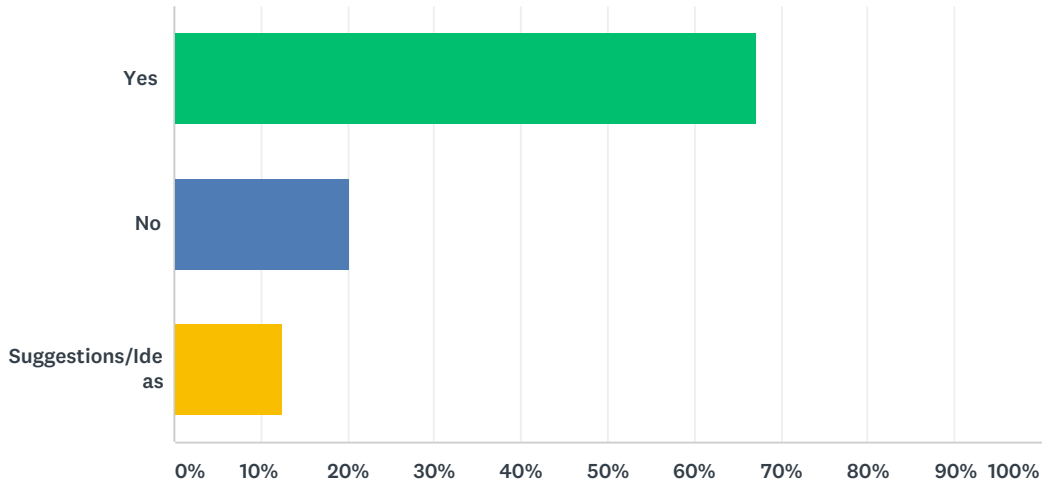
